- ⁵ He is having his morning drink.






- ⁶ **Suddenly**, he hears some noise and quickly

- The carrot is a bait.






- ²² The hare **peeps out** again.

- 27 and pulls out a bigger carrot.






- ²⁸ The hare is watching **both of them**.

- more carrots than the young hunter.





12 36 The hare's head turns left and right. 12

⁶⁴ and throws it back.






- Now, the young hunter takes out his gun
