- 10 They tell me about the future.


- 11 Some stars form different shapes.

 24 And they are not in a line.
 25 I always lose count.
 26 They are spread all over the sky.



- 27 During the day, the sky is sky blue or light blue.
 28 The sun lights up the sky.
 29 Therefore, I cannot see any stars.
 30 It is impossible to see any star then.
 31 When the sun goes down, the sky turns dark blue.
 32 Stars slowly come out.
 33 At night, the sky is black.
 34 When I am at home, I can watch the stars from my window.


- 35 In the city, it is bright.
36 I see less stars in the city.
37 When I go to the countryside, I can see more stars.
38 The countryside is darker than the city.
39 When it is full moon, the sky is very bright.
40 I see less stars when it is full moon.



- 41 Sometimes, I use a telescope.

43 It looks magical.
44 I want to fly to the moon one day.



- 45 Some nights, I also see shooting stars.



46 I go to bed and I keep thinking about the stars.

48 How I wonder what you are




49 I wake up in the morning and the stars are all gone.
